## FLYING SITE OPERATIONAL RULES

- 1. No flying of gas powered aircraft before 9:00 AM. Electrics may fly anytime.
- 2. New Club members shall qualify for "pilot" status in accordance with The Club's **Pilot Checkout Guidelines.**
- **3.** Only pilots and crews are allowed on the flight line.
- **4.** Mufflers are required on all models (dB limit recommended).
- **5.** Testing of engines is to be performed in a specific designated area.
- **6.** The Shelter and Club House may not be used as a pit area.
- 7. The AMA Safety Code shall be displayed when the field is open for Flying.
- **8.** Fliers operating models must display the AMA or Club Membership Card for easy identification.
- **9.** Pilots shall make appropriate announcements or signals when taking off, landing, any emergency, or when persons or aircraft are on the field.
- **10.** Compliance of these safety rules is the responsibility of each Participant.
- 11. DO NOT FLY ALONE, unless signed in as a solo flyer.
- **12.** Alcohol consumption **SHALL NOT** be permitted.
- **13.** Flight operations are allowed from designated pilot stations **ONLY.**
- **14.** Use frequency control pins at all times unless on 2.4 GHz.
- **15.** Sign in when arriving at the field on log located at the frequency pin Station.

- 16. Aircraft may taxi out from the pits. They may not taxi back.
- 17. When 3 or more aircraft are in the air <u>each</u> pilot <u>must</u> have a spotter.
